The best part will be a spending time in your Jaguar on the road with some really nice people.

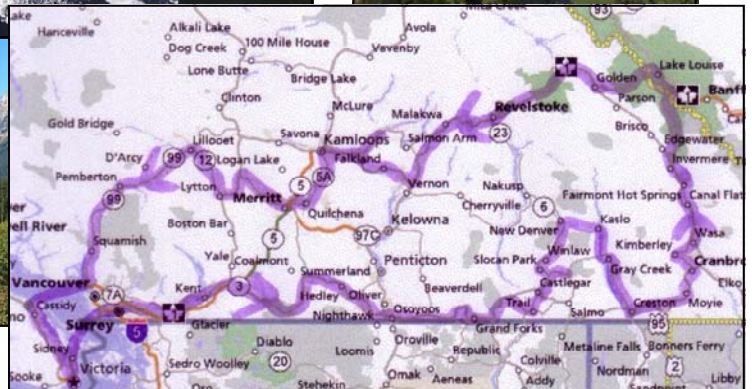
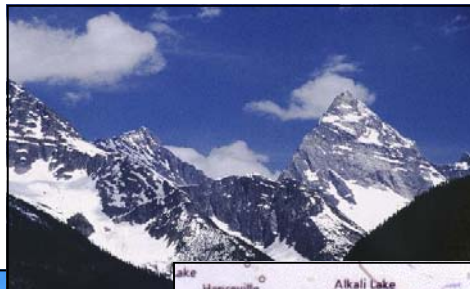
Planning is well underway, so if you are interested, you need to let us know immediately.

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We'll leave Victoria on Monday, July 13th, take an early ferry to Tsawwassen, head east through the Fraser Valley to Hope, on through Manning Park and stay the night in Princeton. Tuesday we'll continue east through Osoyoos and Grand Forks, Rossland and Trail, and on to Nelson where we'll spend the night. Wednesday we will travel north through the Slocan Valley to New Denver, over to Kootenay Lake through Kaslo, across the lake on the Balfour ferry, through Creston and then to Cranbrook for another night. Thursday we'll take in the Columbia Valley, crossing the Continental Divide for a visit to Lake Louise before heading west for a night in Golden. Friday will see us westward bound over Rogers Pass, then a loop through the northern Okanagan and a night just outside of Chase. Saturday we'll pass through the Nicola Valley and Merritt, then west through Spences Bridge, Lytton, Lillooet and along the Duffy Lake Road to Pemberton for the night. Sunday will see us heading south through Whistler and Squamish to Horseshoe Bay for the ferry back to the Island. At many places along the route, there will be options for those who may wish to have a slightly shorter day of driving. We'll have some meals together as a group and others where we'll be on our own. We welcome your participation in any way - join us for the full tour, or take in just part of it - we'd be happy to have you along.
